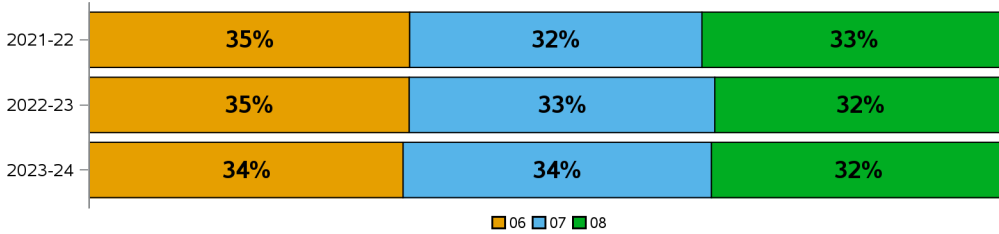

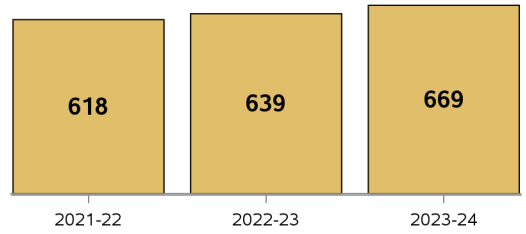

Enrollment by Grade



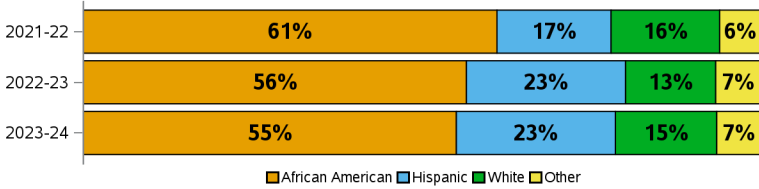
Total Enrollment



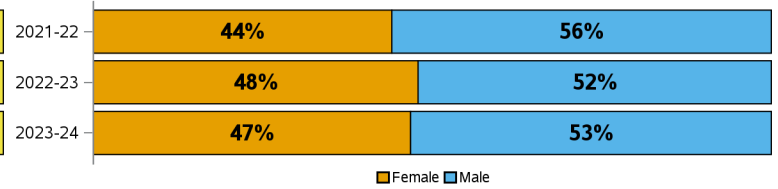

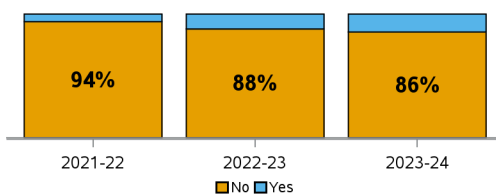
Race/Ethnicity Breakdown



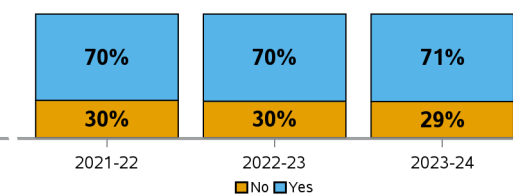
Gender Breakdown



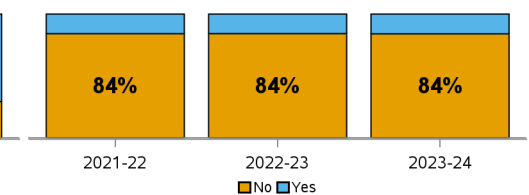

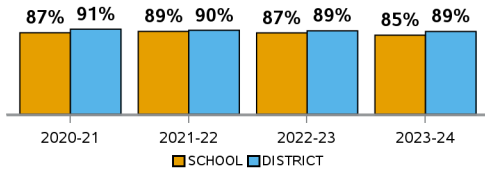

Suspension Event % is determined by the number of total Referrals that had an Internal/Out of School event as part of the Referral.

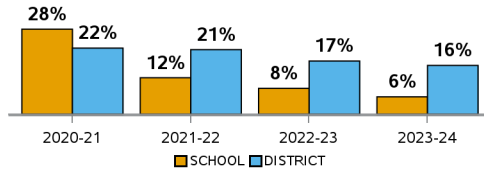

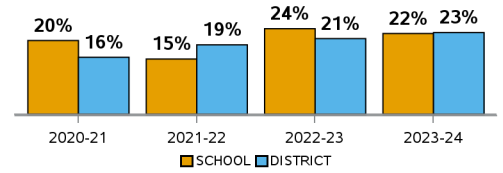

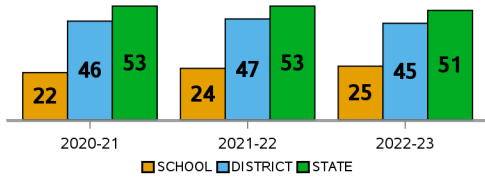
# STUDENT PERFORMANCE

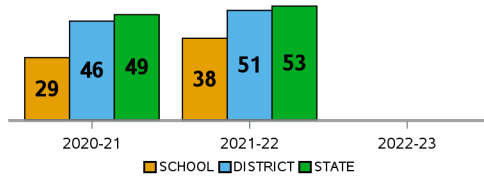

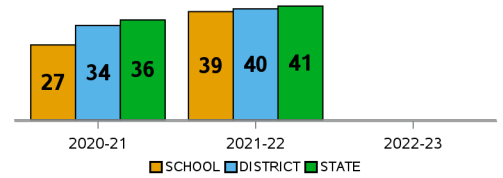

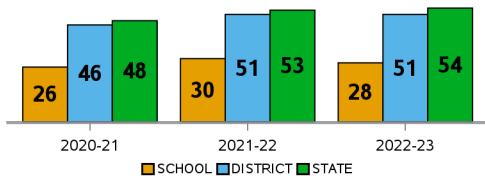

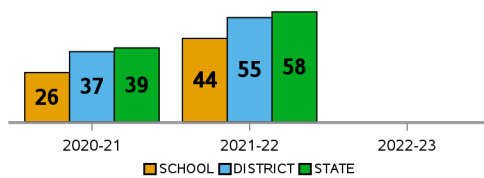

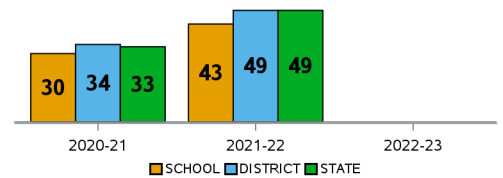

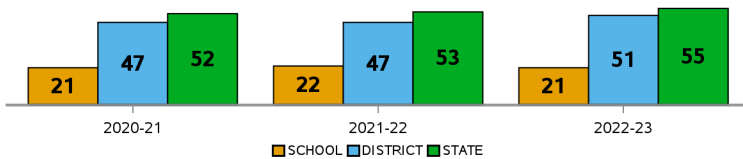

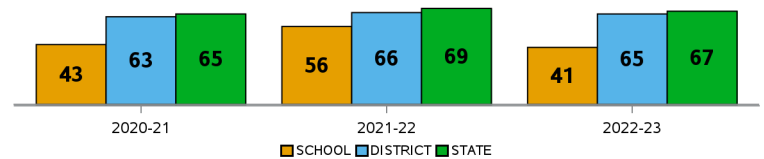

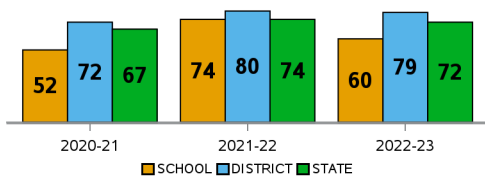

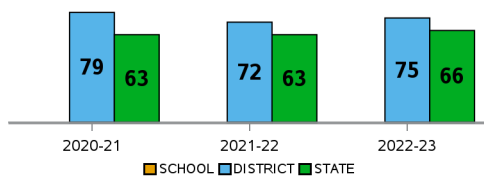
