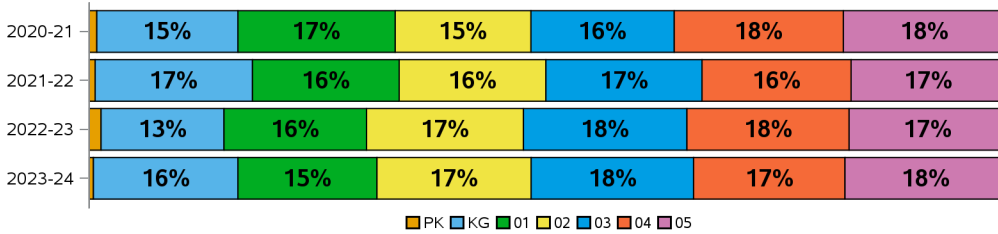

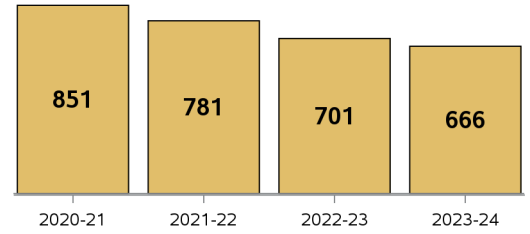

Enrollment by Grade



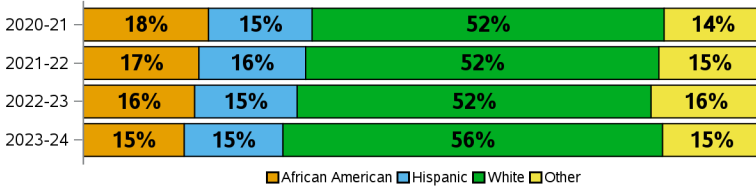

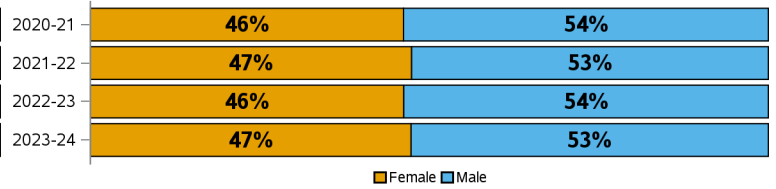

Race/Ethnicity Breakdown



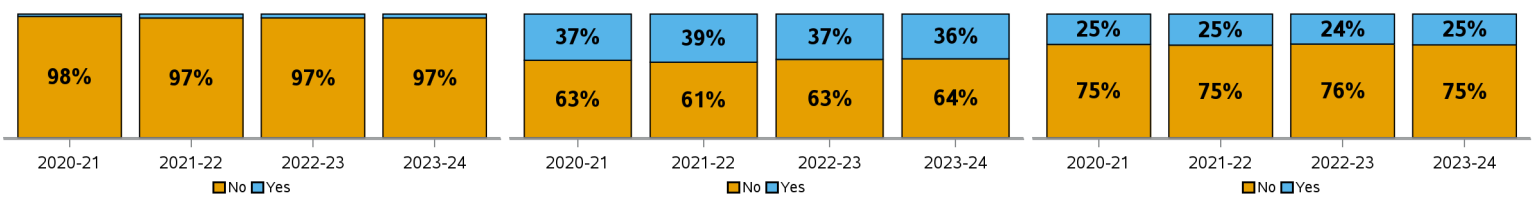
Gender Breakdown

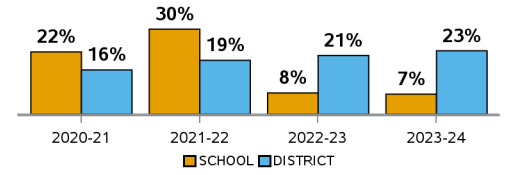

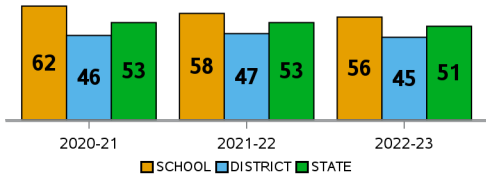
STUDENT PERFORMANCE

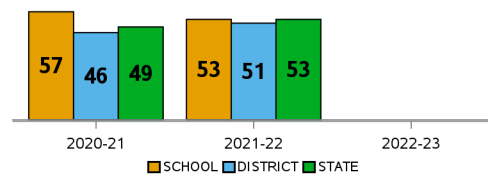

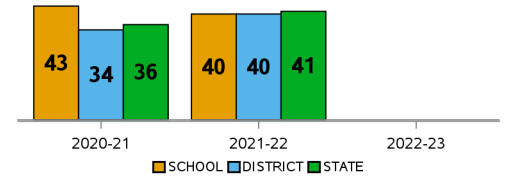

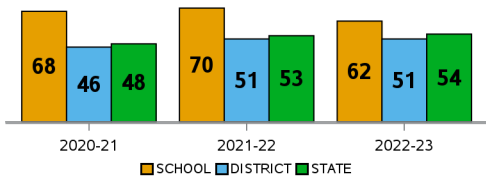
ELA Gains (Bottom Quartile)

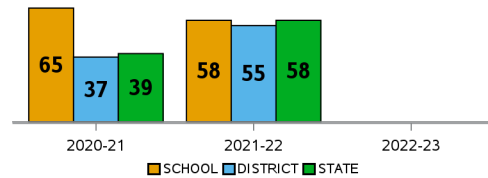

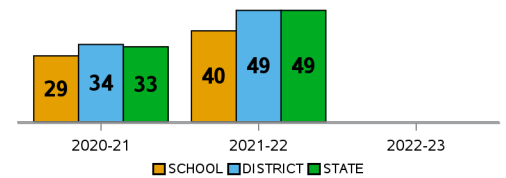

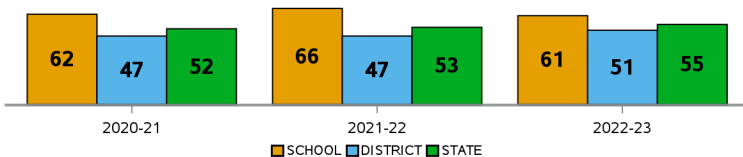

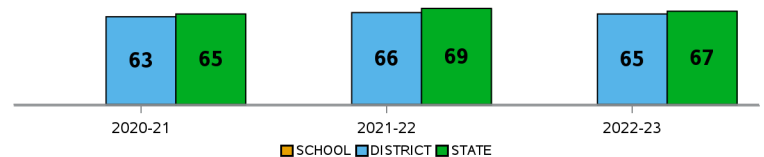

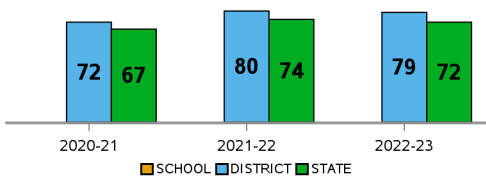

This is the percentage of 8th grade students who are proficient in a High School Honors Course, or earned an Industry Certification the prior year.

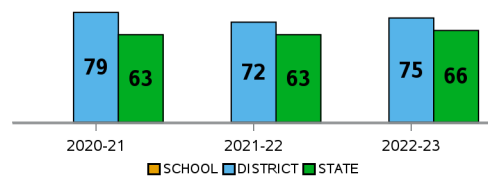
