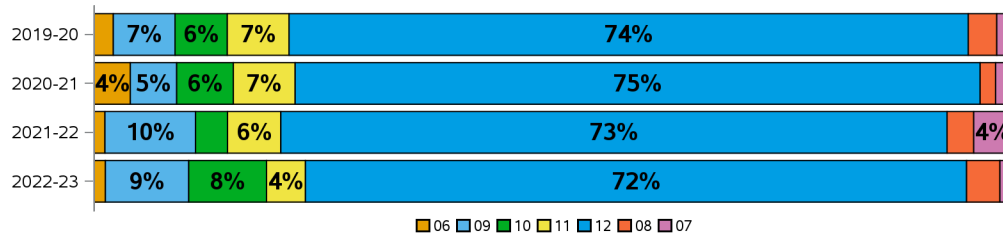

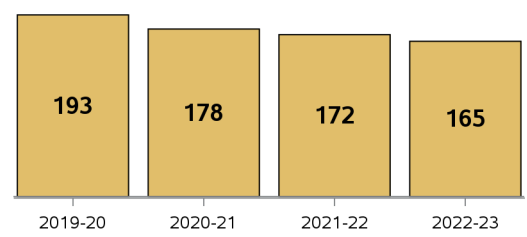

Enrollment by Grade



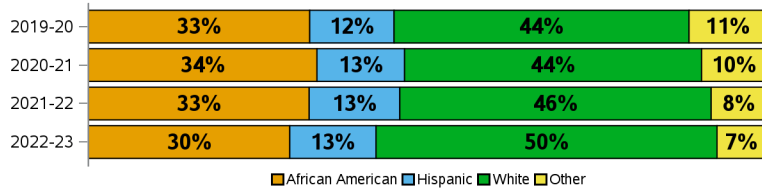

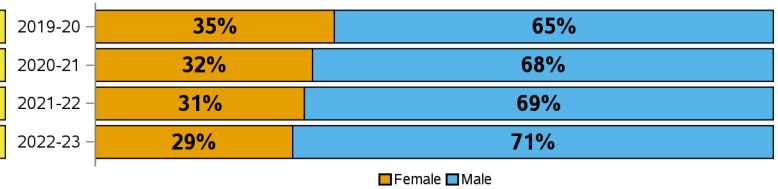

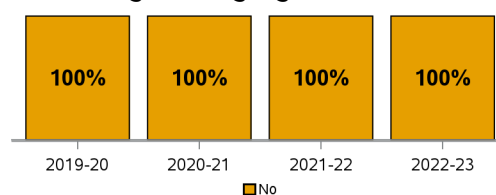
Race/Ethnicity Breakdown



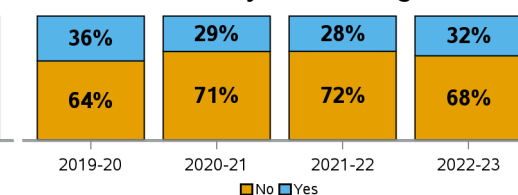
Gender Breakdown



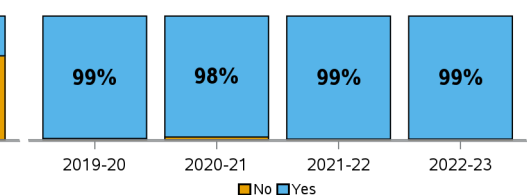

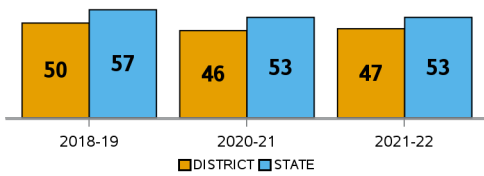

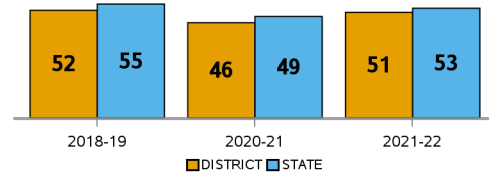

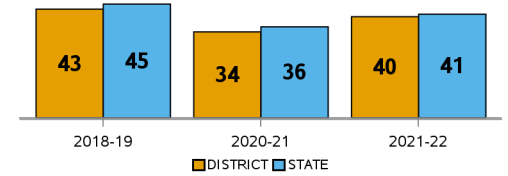

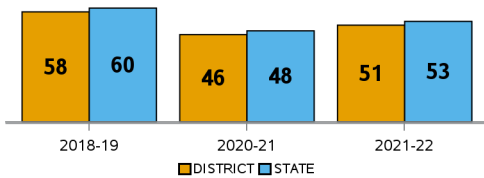

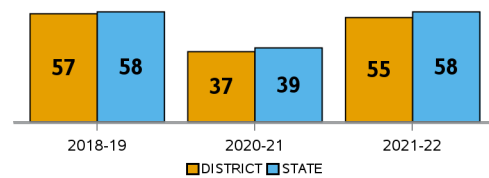

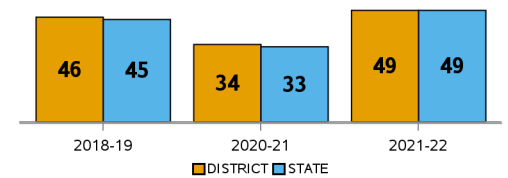

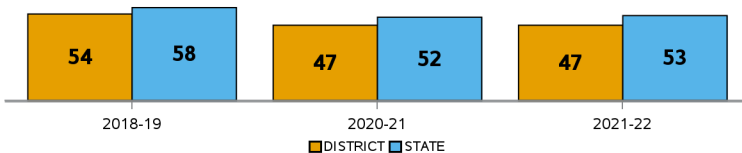

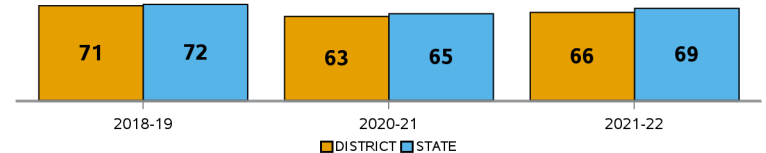

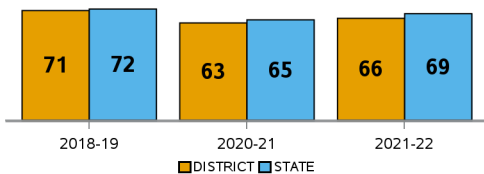

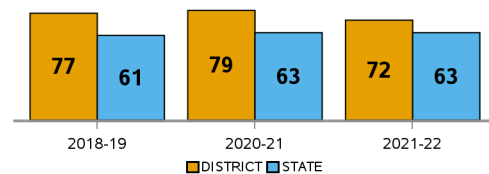
