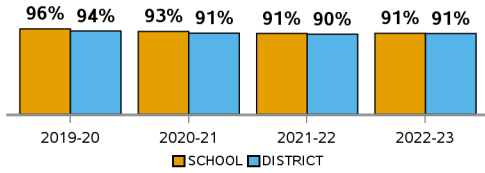

Suspension Event % is determined by the number of total Referrals that had an Internal/Out of School event as part of the Referral.

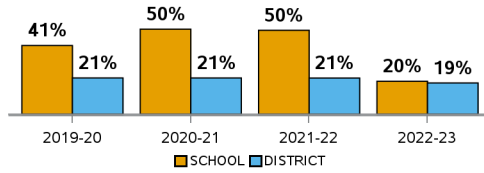

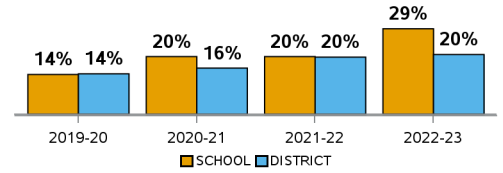

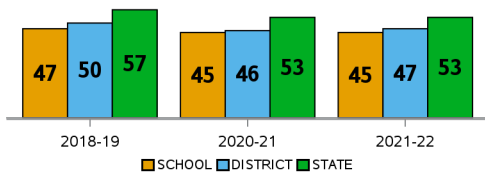

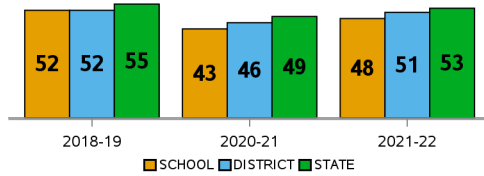

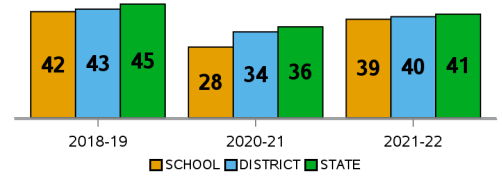

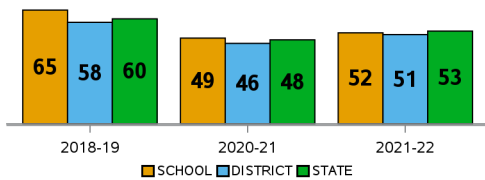

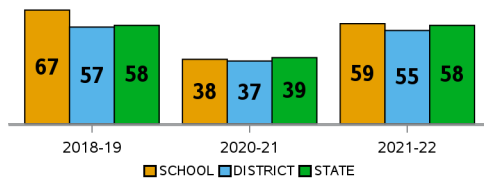

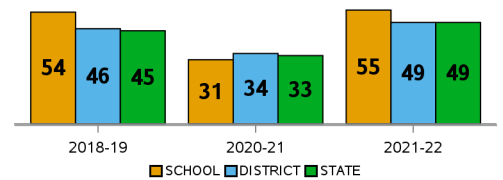

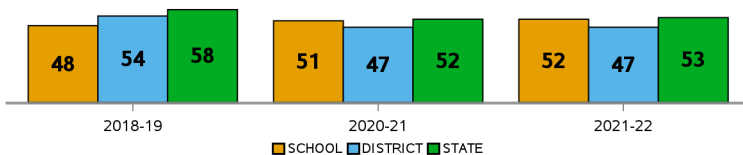

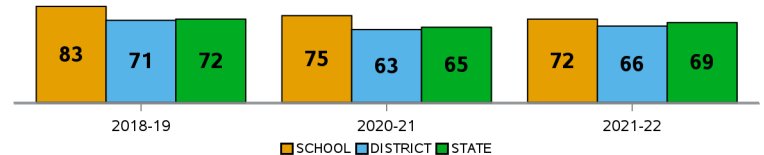

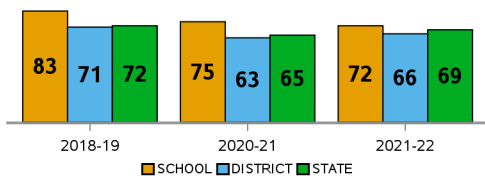

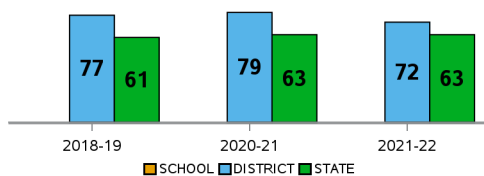
