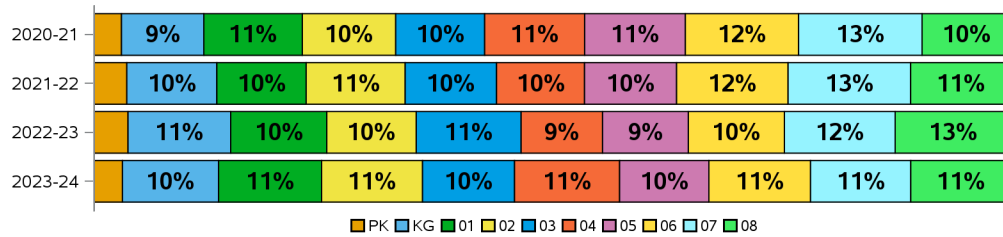

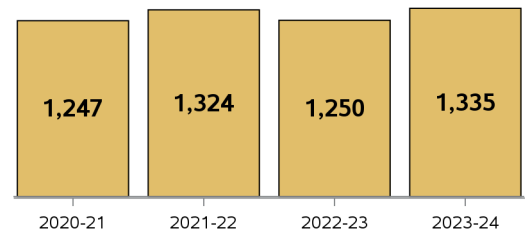

Enrollment by Grade



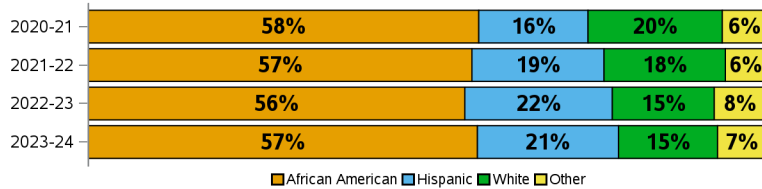

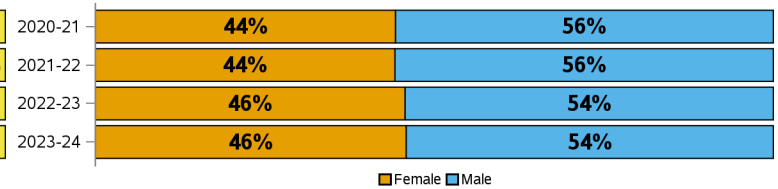

Race/Ethnicity Breakdown



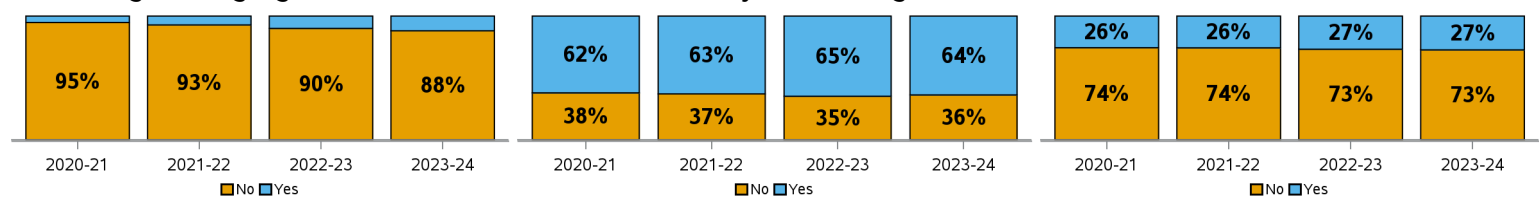
Gender Breakdown

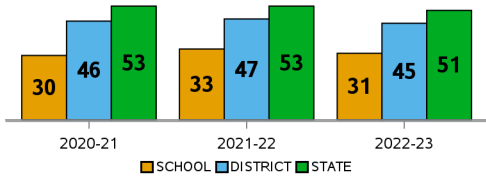
# STUDENT PERFORMANCE

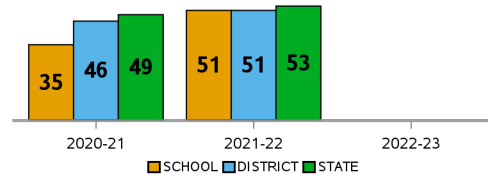

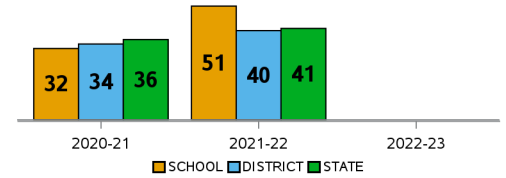

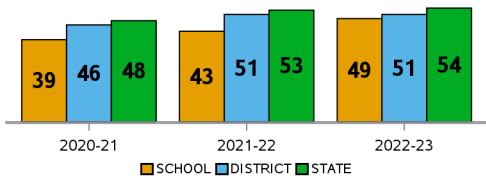

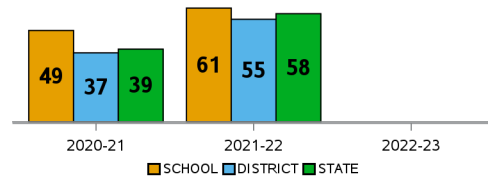

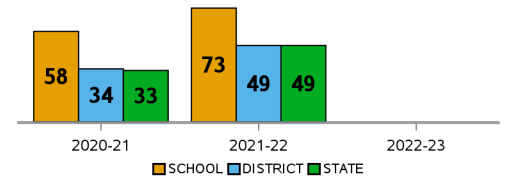

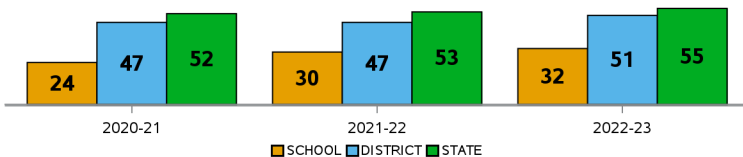

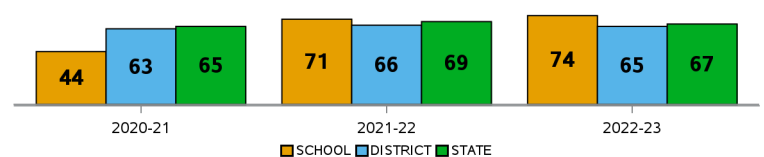

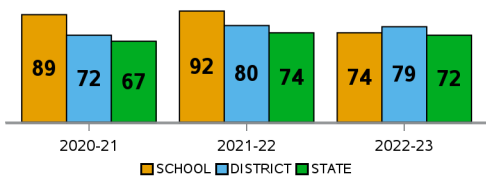

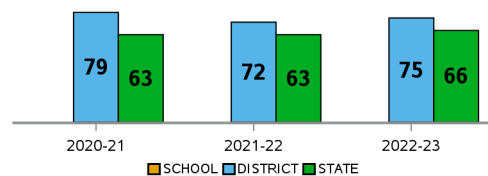
