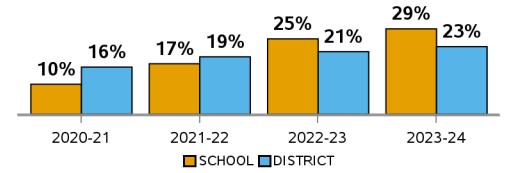

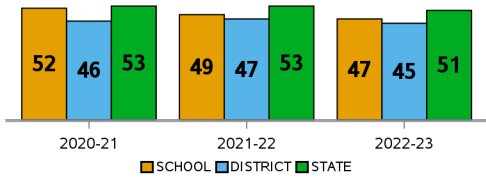
STUDENT PERFORMANCE

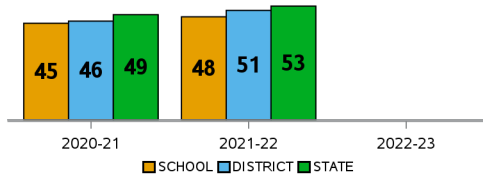

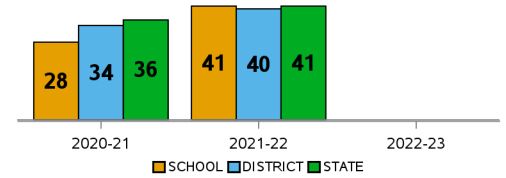

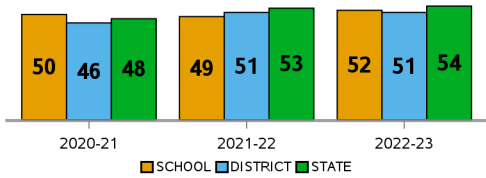

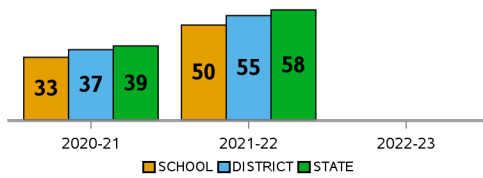

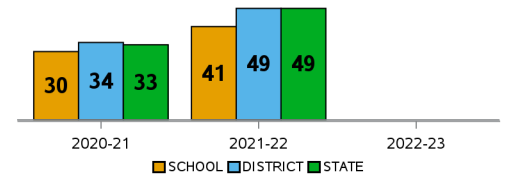

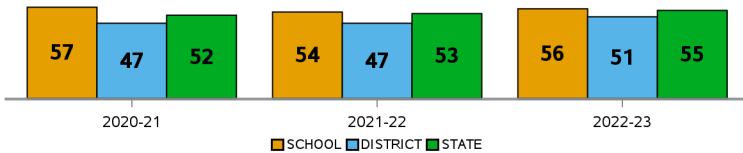

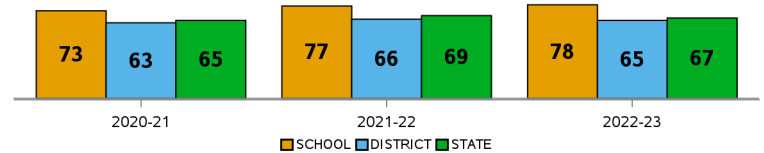

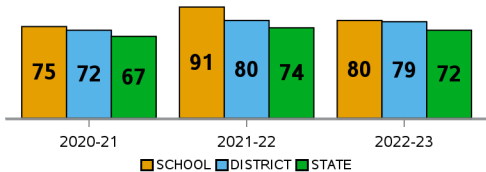

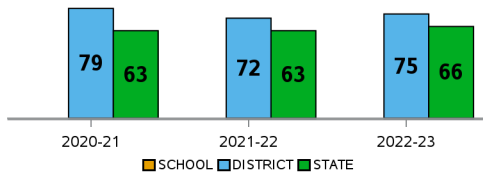
