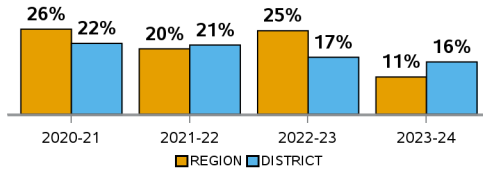

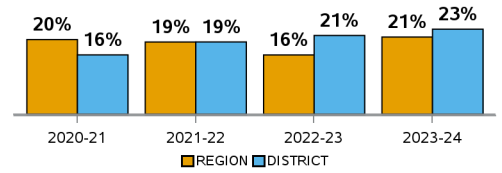

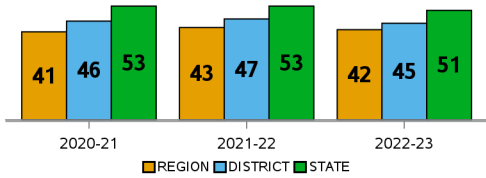
# STUDENT PERFORMANCE

Gain - Percentage of full-year enrolled students who achieved a learning gain from the prior year to the current year. No gains were reported in 2022-23.

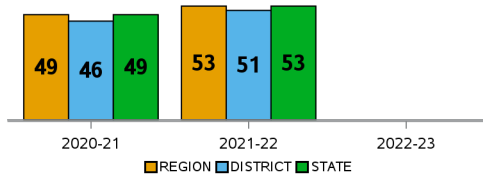

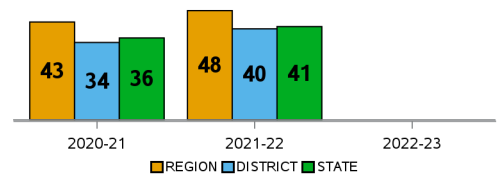

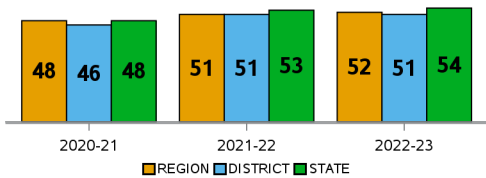

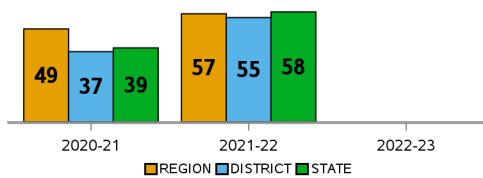

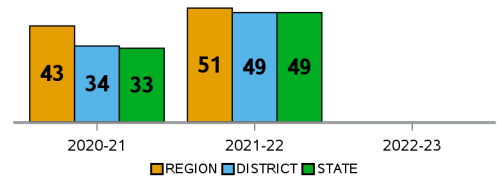

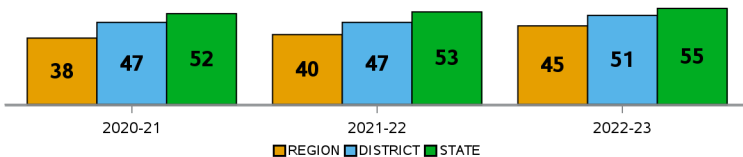

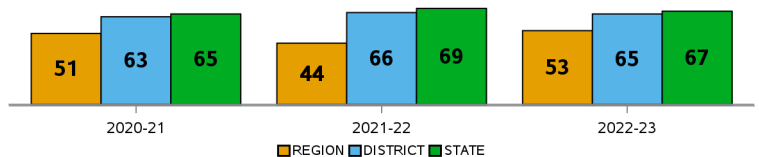

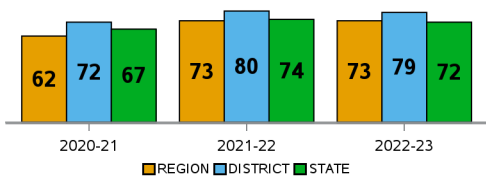

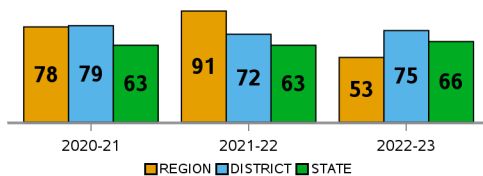
