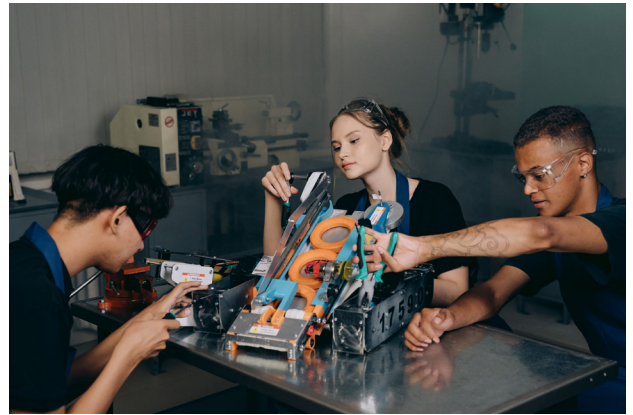




## ABOUT THE PROGRAM / SUMMER 2022

The Mayor's Youth At Work Partnership (MYAWP) provides eligible students with paid internships and job opportunities that prepare them to succeed in employment. Students work with local businesses that offer on the job training and mentorship. In addition to paid internships, students also receive job readiness, financial, and soft skills training along with the support of a job coach. Job coaches assist students through every step of the internship process to help make the experience as meaningful as possible.

- Enrolled in a Duval County High School, GED program, college, or technical school
- 2.0 GPA
- Age 16-21

- Understand career pathways
- Build professional networks
- Learn to manage money
