

SENIOR DUES

Covers senior week activities (listed on other side of this page), graduation costs (which includes the venue, programs, venue parking, venue audiovisual display, security, etc.), and transportation. Prom, Grad Bash, and Cap & Gown are separate costs.

Fees paid by January 30 are \$110.
Fees paid on February 1 or up to March 31 are \$115.
Fees paid on and after April 1 are \$120.

Senior Dues must be paid in order to participate in the graduation ceremony and senior week activities.

Senior Fees must be paid by credit card online.

TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Buses will be provided for all off-campus events, excluding the Baccalaureate ceremony. Included in the senior dues is bus transportation to these events including the Commencement rehearsal, Commencement ceremony, and off campus senior week activities. Students desiring transportation to and from the school must request by sign up before May 1st.

Graduates arrive at the Arena at 7:30 AM for rehearsal. The reheasal will last approximately two hours. Graduates will report to the Arena at 4:30 PM for the ceremony. The primary event parking for both the rehearsal and the ceremony is in Lot 18.

Graduation Tickets:

Each senior will receive 10 graduation ceremony tickets for guests. Graduates do not need a ticket to attend graduation.

Ticket Distribution: Tickets will be distributed to seniors Friday, May 24th at 11:00 AM in the Paxon Auditorium during the cap and gown distribution.

Additional Tickets: Students can make arrangements with other seniors for additional tickets. We anticipate opportunities throughout the year to acquire additional tickets. No one, including babies in arms, toddlers, etc., will be allowed into the venue without a ticket.

A Sign Language Interpreter will be provided by DCPS. Handicapped/Accessible seating is available.

Dress Code:

Please be sure that your gown is pressed before wearing it.

Dresses: a black or dark blue dress that is close to knee length. Please try your dress on with your gown to see how it looks. It should neither hang below your gown (tape it up) nor be so short that you look "bare" under your gown.

Bottoms: Dress slacks (black or dark blue- no khakis)

Tops: White or pale colored dress shirt/blouse; dark, traditional tie

Shoes: black or dark blue dress shoes (no buckles, rhinestones, glitter or embellishments of any kind, or sneakers) With dress- open toe shoes are acceptable (very high heels should be avoided); flesh colored pantyhose. With slacks- black or dark blue dress shoes; dark dress socks (no bare ankles, white/colored socks, or casual shoes/sneakers).

Caps and Gowns:

Graduates are only permitted to wear Paxon provided regalia with their cap and gowns. Decoration of graduation caps and other embellishments are not permitted.

Caps and gowns are purchased through Herff-Jones. The cost is not incluided in senior dues. Contact Herff Jones at (904) 363-1905 for all cap and gown and announcement concerns. Before a student may receive his/her cap and gown he/she must clear all debt. Please see reverse side for debt information.

Distribution of Caps and gowns:

Caps and gowns will be distributed to seniors on Friday, May 24th. Distribution will occur at approximately 11:00 AM in the Paxon SAS Auditorium.

Guests attending the Commencement Ceremony:

Guests will go through a bag-check line and walk through a mag-gate upon entering the Arena. Wanding will be used in the instances the mag-gate is triggered during a walk-through. Clear Bag Policy will be in effect. Acceptable bags are 12" x 6" x 12" clear plastic bags, 1 gallon plastic freezer bag, or clutch with shoulder or wrist straps (clutch may not be larger than 4.5" x 6.5"). Chartered buses are provided and will leave Paxon SAS on Friday, March 31st at 3:30 PM and will return on Saturday, April 1st at 5:00 AM. It is a school day and students MUST attend 1st and 2nd periods at a minimum. Students will report to the auditorium immediately after school for bus loading. Parents picking up students on Saturday morning should arrive by 4:30 AM.

Special Notes:

- ▶ Students may not bring food, coolers, back packs, drinks, water bottles, etc.
- ▶ Security: Police will be hired to protect parked cars until buses return from Grad Bash. However, we strongly recommend that students be dropped off and picked up for this event.
- ▶ Students may not be dropped off or picked up at an alternative location. Please do not ask for special considerations. DCPS liability does not provide coverage for this option.
- ▶ Bags taken into the park must be only half the size of a sheet of notebook paper, including purses and backpacks.

Dress Code:

Students must arrive at school appropriately dressed. They may not change upon arrival at Universal Orlando. Casual attire. Avoid tube tops, strapless, backless, spaghetti strap dresses/tops. Nothing too short or too revealing, no see-through clothing. Students should wear comfortable shoes; flip-flips are not recommended. No hats or bandanas. No clothing affiliated with a school, religion, gang, or team. A dress code for Universal Orlando will be sent home at a later date.
