#### THE FOLLOWING SUPPLIES ARE NEEDED FROM EACH STUDENT

## **PREREQUISITES FOR A SUCCESSFUL YEAR IN THIRD GRADE**

- Be independently responsible for daily tasks.
- Able to read, comprehend and following directions carefully
- Remember and carry out multiple step directions
- Correctly and legibly copy information from the screen
- Independently reading on grade level
- Ability to read for an uninterrupted 15 - 20 minutes daily
- Writing in complete sentences using correct capitalization and punctuation
- Basic addition and subtraction facts 0-30 (instant recall of combinations of 10)
- Rounding to the nearest 10
- Counting by 2's, 5's, 10's
- Understanding even and odd numbers
- Telling time - half hour and hour
- Name of basic polygons (triangles, octagons, etc)

## **GOALS FOR A SUCCESSFUL YEAR IN THIRD GRADE**

  - φ Narrative, Expository, Persuasive, Response to Literature, Procedural and Informational/Report

  - φ Identify, understand and use 23 Non-fiction Text Features
  - φ Independently read and comprehend grade level fiction and non-fiction texts
  - φ Mastery of multiplication and related division facts and concepts
  - φ Identify and classify quadrilaterals
  - φ Develop understanding of fractions and fractions equivalence
  - φ Explore concepts and skills in Physical, Earth, Biological Sciences and Health
  - φ Explore concepts and skills relating to ancient and present day communities
