Principal's Report:

- Have not received budget for next year, Principal meeting Thursday, may get some info then.
- Graduation moved to July, looking at last 2 weeks of July and will be live-streamed.

- Each high school will get a 1-hour block of time (about 45 minutes of programming) on Channel 4 in May to showcase their seniors. Will get info on time slot soon.
- Looking at how to clear out lockers, looking at doing building by building, putting things in bags to limit interaction
- People are waiting for refunds for senior activities. They are making sure they have all the correct addresses. Some will be going out tomorrow.
- Sr. Shirts are arriving this week, working on a plan to get them delivered.
- Want to minimize the number of times people have to come to the building so will look at combining pickups.
- Students reactions to virtual school are a mix. Some are not in happy / safe households, so the school is looking for avenues for them to get support.
- Mrs. Spaulding has been doing a Teams call with students every couple of days.
- The district has not looked at possible changes to enrollment to some students deciding to go fulltime virtual next year. "What we have now is crisis school, not virtual school".
- 40 laptop carts were taken by the district to distribute to students. The stimulus bill did provide some money for districts that lose technology.
- Some people were going to multiple schools to get additional laptops and trying to sell them at pawn shops
- Class Selection: If there is a class that is a natural progression that is not avail, contact guidance and copy Mrs. Spalding and they will work it out.
- Sr. Last day is still scheduled to be the same 5/15/20
- Assumption is that they will be averaging their grades to accommodate for lack of EOC
- SAC will need to vote on a SIP in May. We will not have EOC and FSA for data for this year so we may have to use last years data to create next years' goals.
