Principal's Report:

- Budget– No significant changes expected. Enrollment will be about the same next year
- Currently working on scheduling for next year
- 5 Essential Survey Results – cultural and academic goals
- School Improvement Goals
 - Academic: lowest performing quartile (LPQ) for math: last year +14 points. Supporting LPQ will raise everyone. There will be a whole new Algebra team because of some retiring teachers and teachers moving to Middle school (to teach at their child's school).
 - Cultural: 5-point increase with parent involvement to show gains in the 2020-2021 the school climate 5 essentials survey
- People tend to get “stuck” in their pods, but the virtual school has showed that teachers who have rarely interacted before are now communicating more via Teams because they are not in front of a classroom.
- Will be offering opportunities to provide more parent involvement, family nights, etc.
- Teachers expect Teams will continue to be used next year. Some students felt more comfortable using Teams than FOCUS. Need to use it from the beginning of the school year so all students are comfortable with it.
- SAC has \$15,552.45 in funds. There may be a need to purchase 5 – 6 additional radios (~\$1500) but want to wait until we know what school will look like (Safety and Security is always a priority). SAC funds roll over year to year.
- The laptops remaining at the school will be reimaged over the summer
- Locker cleanout has been going well, teachers will be coming in next week for classroom cleanout.
- Building exterior will be pressure washed and painted over the summer. They think they will also be able to paint the classrooms. Security has tagged large items in the classrooms in case they get pulled out of the classrooms when being painted.
- The signs for the graduates were very well received by seniors and their families
