### **Principal's Report:**

- Planning for PMA3 – indicator for where we are now and how we will be for state testing.
- Trying to get all of the DHR students to come in for PMA3 because the state will require on-site testing (to create a similar experience). Created a form for parents to express their concerns. Looking at the possibility of offering Saturday testing (not approved, would require transportation and lunch). They have received about 300 responses to the form. Mixed results.
- Testing calendar is up and running. For some AP classes, DHR students can test from home (in-person and DHR test may be different).
- Graduation will be in-person on-campus, planning is in progress.
- Grad Bash is happening, and planning is in progress.
- Discussion on Prom are taking place, no official decision yet.
- Enhance security measures went smoothly.
- There was a peaceful protest on Friday, it went very well and opened some good lines of communication.
- Parking
  - Brought in the school police and JSO traffic specialist to observe the traffic.
  - We will remove 3 of the 4 incoming speed bumps because they are harsh and slow traffic too much (the last one will remain). The outbound speed bumps will remain. Requested some additional signage for directing parents and students.
  - SRO will be assisting with traffic in the morning.
  - School police has recommended a new traffic light at the school. Getting a light is a long process.
- Juniors are starting the scheduling process for next year.
- Creating a model academy for CTE (engineering, IT, gaming, web design, TV production – Digital design). Starting to create a board to meet at least 3 times per year to discuss how the program can produce workforce students. We will be tying in the industry certification and the academics (lang arts teacher will work with the CTE teacher to assist with assignments related to the industry – creating scripts, etc.)
- ACHS got a computer gaming lab with high power computers.
