New Business:

Mid-Year Stakeholders Data. Mrs. Gaston shared the mid-year data (power point):

PMAs:

- ELA – we are just below the district average in 3rd and 5th but above in 4th grade. We are above similar schools in our area and just below schools that have a higher SES population than ours.
- Math – we are above the district in 3rd & 5th but significantly below in 4th grade. We are above almost all similar schools in our area but are above a few schools that should be higher than we are.
- Science – we are above the district average. We are higher than most similar schools and just under the area schools with a higher SES population.

I-Ready:

- You can see growth between Fall and Winter diagnostics in reading and math. It's a little difficult to see but note the Green (proficient) is growing and the red (below grade level) is getting smaller. We fully expect it to be even high by the Spring.
