Principal’s Report

- Mid-Year Stakeholders Report

The majority of this month’s meeting provided time to review school data according to the mid-year assessment window. Principal Kimball shared school grade projections, which PMA2 predicts Seabreeze to fall 14 points of an A. Principal Kimball identified areas of concern, and shared prescriptive plans for growth by PMA 3. The next testing window falls directly before Spring Break, ending March 7th.
