# What is Honors in College?

According to NCHC,

- Honors programs may...
  - Compose 15-25% of a student's coursework per semester
  - Accommodate or satisfy other program requirements
  - Be designed for the students in the program
  
- Honors colleges may...
  - Compose 20%+ of a student's coursework p/semester
  - May require a separate application
  - Have extra control over their curriculum
  - May include separate honors housing

# What is Honors?

- Oriented around Critical Thinking
- Interdisciplinary Learning
- Learning from Experiences
- Engagement in Classes and Curriculum
- Sense of Community

# Are All Honors Programs the Same?

## College A:

- Research project
- Global experience
- Community service
- Academic curriculum
- Honors housing
- Scholarships

## College B:

- Additional honors courses
- Capstone experience
- Maintain 3.4 gpa
- Honors retreat
- Honors housing
- Scholarships

# Is It More Expensive?

- Honors programs and honors colleges typically have scholarships that pertain directly to being an honors student. Some may pay for your whole tuition while others may only pay a certain amount.
- Any class in college may have additional fees, but to be an honors student does not require additional tuition.
