How do I become a SENIOR? To promote to 12th grade you must:

- 1
- Have a minimum of 18 credits
 - At least 3 complete English credits
- A total of 4 complete credits in Math and/or Science
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 1.5 on a 4.0 scale (unweighted).

 - Qualifying Math scores are required when exceeding 12 college credit hours or to


enroll in a math/science course.
