Parents with multiple students in the school will receive one car tag. Please help your students to learn their car tag number.</li><li>• Bus Riders – Students will be released to the bus loading zone as their bus arrives.</li><li>• Greenfield Walkers – School personnel will verify the student is in the correct dismissal group daily and escort the group to the gate entrance adjacent to the school. A parent/guardian must be present to 3:00 p.m. to meet the student.</li></ul>

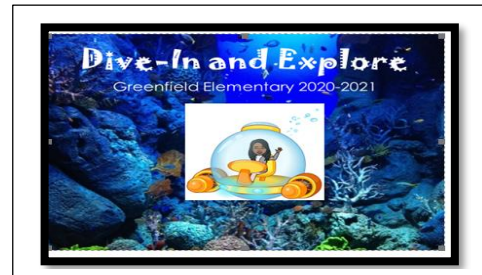
