**To apply for the Seal of Biliteracy, follow these three steps:**

**STEP 1:** Complete the application.

**STEP 2:** Choose a path for qualification: Path A–Language Courses, Path B–Exam, or Path C–Portfolio

**STEP 3:** Submit evidence of your qualifications on the 2023 Seal of Biliteracy (SoBL) Team for your chosen path. Go to **Teams** > click on **Join or Create Team** >

- **Path A–Language Courses** enter **ocrzqis** on **Join a Team with a Code**.
- **Path B–Exam** enter **6n0wh51** on **Join a Team with a Code**.
- **Path C–Portfolio** enter **twq4laa** on **Join a Team with a Code**.
