Forms and requirements

Information included:

*Parking application

*Required documentation

*Eligibility requirements

Who can park:

Must be 16 years old

Must have a valid Florida Driver's License

Must have a 2.0 GPA

Not more than 4 unexcused absences

No class III/IV referrals

What parking lot:

Students will be assigned a designated parking spot

When:

Students must have a decal to park on campus

Vehicles will be towed after the 2nd week of school

Why:

To maintain a safe school environment

Parking on campus is a privilege

How:

Parking applications and all documents must be approved. Once approved money will be collected and a parking spot will be assigned

Submit application with the following documents to Mr. Lakatos during lunch:

1. **COPY** of your FL driver's license
2. **COPY** of your registration
3. **COPY** of insurance card with car information
4. **COPY** of your schedule
5. **\$50 CASH**

Eligibility requirements:

1. 2.0 GPA
2. 16 years old
3. Not more than 4 unexcused PERIOD absences for the prior 9-week period
4. No CLASS III/IV referrals and/or not more than 3 CLASS II referrals for the current/prior school year.
5. *Partial schedule students who do not meet #1-4 will be issued a temporary/probationary pass, but will lose the pass for violations listed below.*

PARKING PRIVILEGES MAY BE REVOKED FOR THE FOLLOWING VIOLATIONS

1. Reckless driving, speeding, or driving anywhere other than in the parking lot.
2. Parking in unauthorized areas, including someone else's parking spot.
3. Leaving school grounds **or attempting to leave** without permission. Leaving or attempting to leave campus with an unauthorized student in the car.
4. Allowing another student to drive your car on campus.
5. Non-compliance with eligibility requirements listed above.
6. Sitting in your car, sleeping in your car, eating in your car, or going to your car for any reason without permission from an administrator or office staff.
7. Students are responsible for decals. A lost decal or misplaced decal (due to car wreck, etc) is the student's responsibility. A lost decal will result in the student having to purchase another decal.

VEHICLES PARKED ON CAMPUS WITHOUT A PARKING PASS WILL BE TOWED.
