To be eligible to participate in FSCJ SLS1103, students must:

- ♣ Have an unweighted high school GPA of 3.0 or above
- ♣ Be classified in Grade 11 or 12, or be in semester 2 of Grade 10
 - Students in grades 11 and 12 may participate with a GPA between 2.5 and 2.99 if they also have a college-ready Reading score on PERT, ACT, or SAT within the last 2 years.

To be eligible to participate in academic dual enrollment courses with FSCJ, students must:

- ♣ Have an unweighted high school GPA of 3.0 or above
- ♣ Be classified in Grade 11 or 12
- ♣ Have college-ready scores in Reading, Writing, and Math* on the PERT, ACT, or SAT, or any combination thereof.

*Students must attempt PERT Math at least one time if they do not already have a college-ready math score on ACT or SAT
 *Students must have a college-ready math score before exceeding 12 college credit hours (4 dual enrollment courses) and/or before enrolling in a math or science dual enrollment course.

Edward Waters University (EWU)

To be eligible to participate in EWU SLS1103, students must:

- ♣ Have an unweighted high school GPA of 2.0 or above
- ♣ Be classified in Grades 11 or 12, or be in semester 2 of Grade 10 with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5.

To be eligible to participate in academic dual enrollment courses with EWU, students must:

- ♣ Have an unweighted high school GPA of 2.5 or above
- ♣ Have a subject-area GPA of 3.0 or above
- ♣ Be classified in Grade 11 or 12

To be eligible to participate in dual enrollment courses with ERAU, students must:

- ♣ Have an unweighted high school GPA of 2.5 or above
- ♣ Be classified in Grade 11 or 12

PLEASE NOTE

- ♣ Students may not enroll in more than THREE (3) dual enrollment courses per semester at maximum, regardless of institution.
- ♣ Students must complete SLS1103 within the first 2 semesters of dual enrollment participation.
- ♣ Dual enrollment course offerings are subject to availability of credentialed faculty and master scheduling needs.
- ♣ Dual enrollment course capacity is limited, and maximum enrollment is set according to the affiliated institution.
- ♣ Students who have previously earned a grade of D, F, FN, or W in a dual enrollment course will not be permitted to continue in dual enrollment without an approved probation application.
