



2021-2022 SY Federal Impact Aid (FIA) Survey Announcement

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The federal presence in our community and the significant tax exemptions available to federally connected personnel, businesses, and agencies identifies Duval County Public Schools as an eligible applicant for the Federal Impact Aid grants.

As you may know, Federal Impact Aid programs and grants are designed to assist local school districts that enroll federally connected students. The grants from these programs are critical for ensuring that all children in Duval County receive an excellent education. Each year, the district uses the Student-Parent Survey for Federal Impact Aid to identify our federally connected students and to support our request for Impact Aid funds. The district's digital survey was released November 22, 2021.

We are requesting that you join Whitehouse Elementary in our effort to have all parents/guardians complete the Federal Impact Aid survey for each child enrolled at Whitehouse. Parents are able to complete a multifamily form or single student form, electronically sign, date, and submit your survey here, at your child's school, or electronically.
