Senior Packages

There are three senior package options this year. Students planning on participating in the graduation ceremony in May must purchase one of these. Payments can be made online (dcps.schoolcashionline.com) or in-person with cash or money order only. The deadline to purchase a Stingray or Ocean package is October 13th. The deadline to pay for a Reef package is

Graduation Tickets

One of the most asked questions regarding graduation is about tickets. Each senior will receive ten tickets to the ceremony. They are then able to earn up to seven additional tickets by meeting the following items (worth one ticket each):

- Post-Secondary Ready (PSR) in Math*
- Post-Secondary Ready (PSR) in Reading*
- Proof of collegiate letter of acceptance or proof of military enlistment with a contract signed
- Acceleration Credit: Earning Dual Enrollment or Industry Certification
- Earn a 60% or higher on the Florida Civics Literacy Exam (FCLE)
- Proof of PTSA Membership
- Parent attends the spring senior parent meeting
